RE: Inspections and Certifications

Dear MCRTA Owners, Operators, Taxi Employees, and Affiliates:

As you know, the MCRTA relies on the Monterey County Department of Weights and Measures to inspect, seal, and certify the taximeters in all taxicabs that operate within the MCRTA's jurisdiction (see Section 27. TAXIMETERS of the MCRTA Regulations). Weights and Measures performs these inspections annually – typically in the months of January and February. As part of the annual inspection process, Weights and Measures also inspects for valid MCRTA licensing, permitting, and certifications. Upon completion of the annual inspections, Weights and Measures provides these records to the MCRTA – in turn, staff reviews these records to ensure all taxicabs remain in compliance.

A review of this year's Weights & Measures inspection records revealed that approximately forty-two (42) taxicabs did not have a valid MCRTA Sticker.

This notification is being provided as a reminder to all MCRTA taxicab owners, operators, and affiliates that operating a taxicab without proper permits, licenses, and certifications within the MCRTA's jurisdiction is a direct violation of the MCRTA's Regulations.

Failure to adhere to the requirements outlined above may result in fines and/or penalties including suspension of your MCRTA operating privileges. Please contact me if you have any questions.

The MCRTA will be notifying the identified Taxicab Owners individually to discuss this matter.
